What we provide:

- **Information, Referral and Outreach** – resources for simple through complex situations, agency overview briefings, expo booths at unit functions, Make My Day Respite Child Care funding, individual needs assessments.
- **Army Family Action Plan** – Identifies Quality of Life Issues, solution-oriented to enhance Total Army Family.
- **Army Virtual FRG Site** – a Family Readiness Group website for service members, and their family members.
- **Army Volunteer Corps Program** - Volunteer Vacancy Information and Placement Assistance, Volunteer Management Training, Community Volunteers Recognition Events.
- **Exceptional Family Member Program** – Assistance for family members with special needs.
- **Family Advocacy Program** – Parent education & playgroups, New Parent Support Plus Program, victim advocacy, healthy life skills education, sexual assault prevention/education.

- **Relocation Readiness Program** – Welcome packets, newcomer's orientation, lending closet, PCS briefings and individual planning,
- **Pre-Arrival, Arrival, and Pre-Departure Support**—Programs covering sponsorship, local orientation and policies.
- **Sexual Assault Prevention and Victim Advocacy Programs**—information, help, and reporting links.
