Mission Statement- Operation Homefront (OH) provides emergency financial and other assistance to the families of our service members and wounded warriors. The Oklahoma Chapter of the national nonprofit Operation Homefront provides emergency assistance and morale support for Oklahoma's Afghanistan and Iraq veterans/families of all services, active, National Guard and Reserve.

What We Provide

- Emergency Assistance for Food, utilities, finances, to include disaster relief.
- Travel expenses in support of a wounded warrior or family.
- Local moving expenses to relocate a veteran/family to a more financially feasible situation or to provide a wounded or disabled veteran a better care-giving situation.
- Home/appliance, auto repairs, including retrofitting to accommodate injuries.
- Social outreach and morale support for Oklahoma military families, provided by donated products or funds from national or local sponsors, including Christmas Adopt-a-Family, Holiday Basket Giveaways, Back-to-School Supplies and other events.
- Referrals to other agencies when a veteran/family has a need that does not fit the emergency support mission statement of Operation Homefront Oklahoma.

Who We Help- junior enlisted veterans/families (E1 to E6), up to two years after the date of the service member's discharge). However, the Chapter has flexibility through a Granting Committee to expand the ranks of the military sponsor and family to be supported, as determined on a case-by-case basis. The veteran or family member must provide proof of service in the form of a military ID card or DD Form 214. The Chapter does not provide financial assistance to pay cell phone or credit card bills.
